Cooperation and Exchange Memorandum of Understanding

The Guangzhou Library and the Berio Library, hereinafter referred to as "The parties", for common development of the two libraries, agree to share information, collaborate on projects, carry out exchanges.

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

- 1) On the basis of the friendship and cooperation of the two institutions, the parties will work together to share knowledge and carry out professional and academic exchanges.

ARTICLE II: EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION ACTIVITIES

- 1) Both parties will engage in a mutual exchange of new knowledge, best practices, and discussion & cooperation on matters of common interest that will contribute to the development of the library.
- 2) The parties will provide both expatriates & citizens of their respective nations universal access, under the current library rules, to books and other material containing new knowledge and information.
- 3) In order to share knowledge and cooperate on matters of common interest, librarians from both parties will consult with one another at regular intervals. Librarians will also be invited to participate in international exchanges.
- 4) Both parties will hold exchanges based on independently developed reading and cultural activities.
- 5) Both parties will endeavor to consult before engaging in any other activities with each other than those already agreed upon.

ARTICLE III: OBLIGATIONS OF PARTIES

- 1) Both parties will be responsible for the execution and agreed financial costs associated with exhibitions or exchange activities related to the memorandum.

ARTICLE IV: DURATION OF MEMORANDUM AND TERMINATION PROCESS

- 1) The memorandum will take effect upon the date of signature of both parties and be valid for five years from the date of signature. If the memorandum is not terminated by either party upon expiration, it will be considered extended.

ARTICLE V: AMENDING THE MEMORANDUM

- 1) Both parties must agree in advance to any possible amendments or modifications to the content of the memorandum.

This Memorandum of Understanding is not intended to be legally binding.

The memorandum was signed in 2 copies in English Language, both texts being equally authentic.

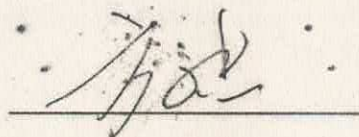
